PRIZES

Environment winner: £150 plus commemorative plaque and Nazeing Glass Rosebowl

Community winner: £150 plus commemorative plaque

Peterkin Award for an individual making an outstanding contribution to village life: Rosebowl

Dorothy Abel Smith Award for a young person making an outstanding contribution to village life: Pewter Dish

Judges Commendations: framed certificates awarded at the judges' discretion
