Policy SP 22 proposes the creation of a major urban extension to the north-west of Hatfield that would include the construction of 1,650 dwellings. All of the land covered by the proposal lies within the Green Belt as defined in the extant Local Plan.

CPRE Hertfordshire considers that this proposal is unsound by virtue of being both unjustified and inconsistent with the policies set out in the NPPF, and in particular paragraphs 14 (on Sustainable development and local planmaking), and 79 to 81 and 83 to 84 (on Green Belt).
