No exceptional circumstances have been set out by the Council for the removal from the Green Belt of proposed housing sites HS28, HS29 and HS30, for in excess of 250 dwellings beyond the southern edge of Cuffley, contrary to national planning policy (NPPF paragraph 83).

Development of these sites would have a major impact on three of the stated purposes of the Green Belt, and the consequential linear projection of Cuffley south-westwards into the highly sensitive area of Green Belt between Cuffley and London that would result from proposals HS28 and HS29 is contrary to good planning practice as well as long established Green Belt policy for the area. No justification for the removal of these sites from the Green Belt is set out other than a general claim in the text that the Council's housing target needs to be spread across the whole Borough.

CPRE Hertfordshire contests this target which is excessive and based on aspirational employment and economic factors, not objectively assessed need, contrary to national planning policy.

These proposals are therefore unsound, in that they are not justified by the evidence presented by the Council, and because housing target for the Borough, as explained in our representations on Policy SP 2.
