Paragraph six of this Policy states that higher density development 'will be encouraged' in accessible urban locations with good access to services, but CPRE Hertfordshire considers that this approach is inadequate in the context of new NPPF policies that demand that the Council maximises opportunities for regeneration and reuse of previously developed land before removing land from the Green Belt for development. Paragraph 137 requires the strategy to 'make as much use as possible of suitable brownfield sites and underutilised land', and 'optimises the density of development', and refers to a whole new policy chapter (11) 'Making effective use of land'.

The Policy should therefore include minimum density requirements in the Policy that reflect their location and character, consistent with NPPF paragraphs 122 and 123 in particular. Those minimum densities should be set at a higher level than the advisory densities currently referred to in the Policy. In any Broad Locations that are retained in the Plan there should be a minimum housing density of 60 units per hectare in accordance with policy advice for newly planned large land areas, and 100 per hectare for apartments/flats in accessible urban locations near public transport interchanges.
