In the knowledge that an Inspector appointed to examine the Plan will not be able to formally recommend modifications to the 'Local Plan Policies Map' CPRE Hertfordshire nevertheless wishes to point out that the Map provided by the Council shows two very large areas of Green Belt, one east of Hemel Hempstead, and one at Park Street as 'Transport Strategy (improvements in Green Belt)' referring to Policy L18.

Unfortunately Policy L18 merely refers to two potential projects that are not included in any adopted Plan and cross refers to 'the IDP', apparently the 2016 Infrastructure Delivery Plan. Policy S6 (xi) refers to Transport network improvements and a 'park and rail facility' at Park Street, but the area shown would double the current built up area of Park Street with a major impact on the Green Belt, effectively merging the proposed 'new village' there with the existing village.

The area of Green Belt shown in both cases has not been shown to be necessary, and is not made clear in Policy S6, and both are considered to be unjustified by supporting evidence and contrary to national policy.
