Whilst CPRE Hertfordshire supports a strategy for a hierarchy of settlements, and Categories 3 and 4 as set out in the Policy, we strongly object to the following elements of the Policy:

- London Colney should not be included as a Category 1 'main settlement', but moved to Category 2, and the key diagram amended accordingly. Similar policies should be applied to London Colney as the other large villages in the District including Redbourn and Wheathampstead, commensurate with their services and infrastructure.
- 2) We oppose the creation of a new settlement at Park Street for the reasons set out in our representations on Policies S2, S4, and S6, and its inclusion as a Category 2 settlement. The proposal is not justified by exceptional circumstances that outweigh national policy as set out in the NPPF designed to constrain urban sprawl, protect the countryside from encroachment and prevent the merger of settlements in the Green Belt.
- 3) We strongly oppose the eastward expansion of Hemel Hempstead into the District and the inclusion of the town as a Category 1 settlement in St Albans. The expansion proposals are not justified by exceptional circumstances that outweigh national policy as set out in the NPPF designed to constrain urban sprawl and protect the countryside from encroachment.
- 4) The first sentence of the Policy for Category 2 villages should seek to influence the density of new development, and not just reflect the existing density of development. Please also see our representations on Policy L1 on density of development.
