I write with reference to the above application following previous correspondence on earlier applications for this site, most recently in February 2020. Our previous concerns regarding development in the Green Belt, as identified in the adopted Broxbourne Local Plan, remain but we are aware that discussions with planning officers have continued and the previous application remains undetermined.

It is clear that the present application for eight houses extends beyond the line of development established in the adjacent consent at White House Farm, and thus affects the openness of the Green Belt in this area. If the Council is minded to approve this outline application, CPRE Hertfordshire would urge the Council to limit the extent of the proposed development to no further than the line established by the adjacent consent and the effective boundary of the built-up area.
