Application no. 07/22/0351/F Land to the East of Stanford House, Burnt Farm Ride, Goffs Oak, EN7 5J Proposed erection of one four bedroom dwelling

I write with regard to the above application, following numerous recent applications in this location. CPRE Hertfordshire has previously responded to these proposals and continues to object to this application for the following reasons.

- The site is located in the London Metropolitan Green Belt as identified in the adopted Broxbourne Local Plan according to criteria in the National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF). Development is thus regarded as inappropriate unless very special circumstances can be demonstrated.
- 2. Numerous previous applications have been made for several houses in the Green Belt and we support the Council's refusals in these cases. We note that this application is for a single house to the east of the existing barn with a new access from the south.
- 3. No attempt is made in the Applicant's inadequate Design and Access Statement to address any very special circumstances, other than to suggest that the present proposal is less than previous proposals and to assert that it will 'have no detrimental effect in the immediate area.' Information regarding the proposed layout of the site and setting is also inadequate but it appears that the proposal is for an entirely new house immediately adjacent to the existing barn east of Stamford House but with a separate access and extensive residential curtilage.
- 4. It remains the case that this proposal constitutes a direct intrusion into the Green Belt without justification of any kind. It would be visually separate from the existing group of buildings including the listed Stanford House, and directly affect the openness of the Green Belt in this location.
