## Application no. 5/2023/0168 Land south of Bricket Wood Social Club, Lye Lane, Bricket Wood Construction of detached dwelling with new vehicular access and associated parking and landscaping

I write with regard to the above application, to which CPRE Hertfordshire objects for the following reasons.

- The site is located in the London Metropolitan Green Belt as defined in the St Albans
   District Local Plan Review according to criteria in the National Planning Policy Framework.
   Development is regarded as inappropriate in the Green Belt unless very special
   circumstances apply.
- 2. No attempt has been made by the applicant to demonstrate very special circumstances, other than to quote housing need generally in St Albans City and District, and suggest that the proposed development constitutes 'in-filling'. The provision of one unit may be seen as 'de minimis' in the context of housing need when set against the harm caused by a large house in a protected wooded area which is highly valued and a significant element in the character of the area.
- The proposed house would not be adjacent to neighbouring property on both sides and the impact on protected trees would be considerable. The Green Belt provides considerable amenity in this area and we believe that its loss would be keenly felt by the local community.
- 4. The Government has recently reaffirmed its commitment to the protection of the Green Belt in ministerial statements and commentary related to the NPPF Prospectus and Levelling Up and Regeneration Bill.
